

GDT's Dangerous Goods Courses are run fortnightly and individuals can be booked to take part in these courses. Alternatively if you have a number of staff requiring Dangerous Goods Endorsements we are happy to tailor a course to suit your timing, and can run the course at your location if required

By attending the "D" endorsement course and gaining the required competence you will be able to transport Dangerous Goods products on a road, forklift operators who are loading vehicles when the driver of the vehicle is not there, must also attend a Dangerous Goods Course

You will cover:

Documentation
Segregation
Placarding
Labelling and marking
Responsibilities

Course Options

Option 1 Full Dangerous Goods Course	Required for transport operators to gain a "D" endorsement on their licence, also required for forklift operators loading Dangerous Goods
Option 2 Dangerous Goods Renewal Course	Required for transport operators after their "D" endorsement has expired (5 years)

Course Prerequisites

Option 1	No licence is required to sit the Dangerous Goods Course
Option 2	This must be done within 12 months of the "D" endorsement expiry date

Important Information

On successful completion and processing we will forward you your certificate, if you are completing the course for licensing purposes you will need to take the certificate to a licensing agent to be endorsed onto your licence within 60 days
