

GDT's Forklift courses are run fortnightly, and individuals can be booked to take part in these courses. Alternatively if you have a number of drivers requiring forklift training and "F" endorsement we are happy to tailor a course to suit your timing, and can run the course at your location if required. The course is run over one day and takes approximately six hours.

Operator Competency Certification

Operator Competency Certification is a prerequisite for the operation of forklifts in the workplace. The course is run in accordance with the OSH publication Approved Code of Practice for Training Operators and Instructors of Powered Industrial Lift Trucks (forklift) also the course is based on the New Zealand Qualifications Authority Unit Standard 10851.

You will cover:

- Pre vehicle safety checks
- Stacking and de-stacking
- The safe operation of the Forklift
- Stability Triangle
- Parking and storage

Course Prerequisites

Option 1	To gain Operator Competency Certification you are not required to hold any licence, but must be at least 15 years of age
Option 2	To gain the F Endorsement you must hold a Full NZ Class 1 licence
Option 3	To gain the F Endorsement you must hold a Full NZ Class 1 licence

Important Information

On completion you will be issued with a certificate for the operator competency, valid for three years, If you do the F Endorsement you will be issued a separate certificate which must be presented to a licencing agent to be endorsed onto your licence.
